

## To remove and replace DVI KVM board for rear-kit

(1) Before your work, please make sure that **the power is disconnected.**

**Step 1: Remove the top rear cover behind the LCD panel**



Remove this rear top cover, 5 on top, 4 on each side.

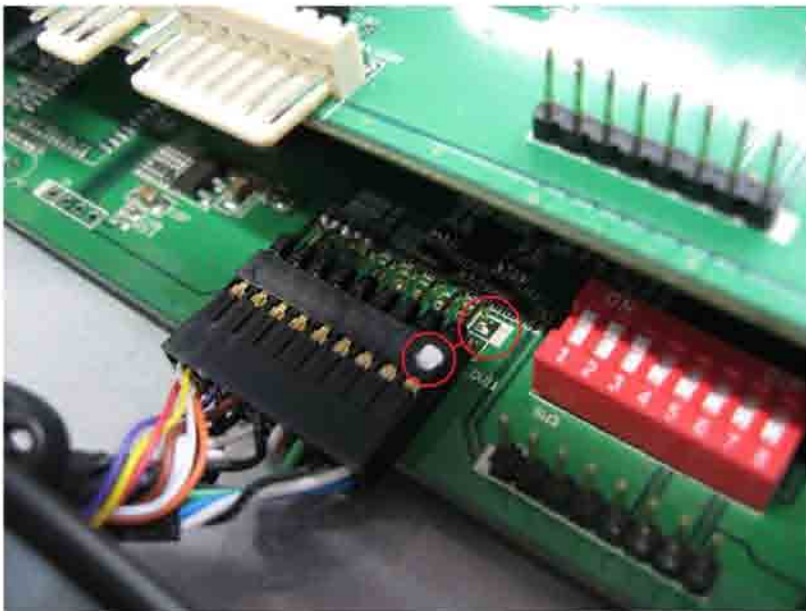
**Step 2: Disconnect all the connector on DVI KVM board carefully to prevent the damage to the wires.**



**Step 3:** Remove all the hexagonal bolts for port #1, #4, #6, #7, #10, #12, and then remove the old DVI KVM board.



**Step 4:** Finally, please follow Step 3 to Step 1 to install back the rear kit, rear-kit cover & top cover to complete the procedure of replacement.



**NOTE:** When connect back the cable, please make sure the “white dot” is facing up to match the right pin-out.
